Supervisor Smith advised he had contacted RG&E and they had no knowledge of said street light. He will contact them again and request that one by installed.

# MUNICIPAL ENDORSEMENT FOR GENESEE LIBRARY TO APPLY FOR NYS PARKS, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT

**WHEREAS,** the Genesee Library is applying to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) for a grant under Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 for a park project to be located at 8351 State Route 417, Little Genesee, New York 14754, a site located within the jurisdiction of the Genesee Town Board; and

**WHEREAS**, as a requirement under the rules of this program, said Genesee Library must obtain the "approval/endorsement of the governing body of the municipality in which the project will be located";

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the Genesee Town Board that they hereby approve and endorse the application for said Grant under Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 for a park project known as the Genesee Library and located within this community; and

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that should the Genesee Library be unable to do so, said property shall be forever maintained by the Town of Genesee as a municipal park in this community consistent with the rules promulgated by OPRHP. Supervisor Smith made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CP Estabrook, to approve this resolution.
